I'm only 3 interviews into talking to people about the scheduler, but so far:

- People seem to schedule most often for the same day
- They seem to schedule for 10-15 minutes out, in keeping with their traffic calendar (see image below)
- Scheduling feature packages [like for "furniture week" (which is a real thing and also something I would make up if not a real thing)] happens, but that might take place on a Friday before a Monday.
- Embargoed stories might get scheduled a week out, but that's super rare.

All of this is to say that we might consider the time being the first set of inputs from the left, with date (defaulting to today's date) as a secondary input.
